

STAR STORIES: EXPLORING THE NIGHT SKY



DESCRIPTION

Students learn about constellations and their cultural significance by creating their own star charts and writing a myth about their constellation.

OBJECTIVES

- Understand the cultural significance of stars.
- Develop storytelling and artistic skills.



MATERIALS

- Black paper, white pencils or markers.
- Access to stargazing apps or star charts.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Introduce major constellations and their stories.
2. Ask students to create their own constellation and a story to accompany it.
3. Share and discuss their creations.

TIPS FOR THE EDUCATOR

- Incorporate stories from different cultures to highlight diversity.
- Plan an evening stargazing session if possible.
